Red Cross Lifeguard Certification

For any individual 15 years and older looking to become a certified lifeguard, this class is for you. The class will be held April 2nd - April 6th from 12:00pm - 4:00pm and costs \$160. Before registering for the class, participants will have to pass a prerequisite swim test of swimming 300 continuous yards using front crawl and/or breaststroke, 2 minutes of treading water without the use of arms, and a timed 20 yard swim with the retrieval of a 10 pound brick. This certification will qualify to apply for a lifeguarding position with the Aquatic Center but does not guarantee employment.
