Chairman Ann Parks began the meeting at 8:00 PM.

CASCADE BUILDING

680 Pittsford –Victor Road

Mr. Parrone presented modifications for the Cascade Building, discussing: shutters, porch entrance, sidewalk, landscape screening and foundation plants, removal of split rail fence, sign, and lighting.

The Board then detailed what Parrone Engineering needs to submit to it as required by the application 3/11/08 for the Cascade Building:

Drawings, Samples, Colors of:

1. Directional signage
2. Shutters on all elevations of the building (including “hang detail”)
3. Sidewalk—at south side to be brick, pattern (running bond)
4. Landscaping on south side—indicate planting material, size
5. Landscaping on east side adjacent to new parking—planting, size (low)
6. Railing at east porch—material, design
7. Sign at road setback—material, design
8. Side porch door, railing and step—catalog cut, design (elevation & details), material
9. Light pole—replace where removed—catalog cut
10. Update all building elevations—spell notes correctly, remove building sign, represent what is there & what is new
11. Update site plan to represent what is new—coordinate correct details, verbiage & specifications

Mr. Parrone indicated that all of this will be delivered to a board member, Mr. Wise, within 5-6 days, for the Board’s study and approval. Due to pending deadlines and presentation to the Planning Board March 19 & to the Zoning Board March 24, this Board agreed to see the final application within the next 10-12 days if possible.
