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At a regular meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Perinton, held at the Town Hall, 1350 Turk Hill Road, Fairport, New York, on March 11, 2015 at 7:30 p.m., local time, there were

The following Order was introduced by Councilperson LaFay and the adoption thereof was seconded by Councilperson Havens:

WHEREAS, a written Petition, dated March 5, 2015, has been presented and filed with the Town Board, requesting the establishment of Extension No. 61 to Perinton Consolidated Sewer District No. 8 to include the area described in said Petition as hereinafter set forth signed by the owners of taxable property situate in the proposed Extension.

WHEREAS, it is proposed that all of said improvements will be installed at the sole expense of the Petitioner who will also furnish easements and will pay all costs incurred in the creation of said Extension without any cost or expense to the Town of Perinton, and

WHEREAS, the area proposed to be established as Extension No. 61 to Perinton Consolidated Sewer District No. 8 is described in said Petition as follows:

All that tract or parcel of land situate the Town of Perinton, County of Monroe, State of New York as shown on a map entitled "Janders Run Subdivision" prepared by Parrone Engineering, dated November 6, 2014, and being more particularly bounded and described as follows:

Beginning a point in the southwest corner of Lot 63 of Turk Hill Estates, Section 7, filed in the Monroe County Clerk's Office, Liber 196 of Maps, Page 86; said point being the northwest corner of Lot I of the Janders Run Subdivision,

Thence, 1 - N 89° 52' 46" E, a distance of 120.00 feet to a point,

Thence, 2 - S 00° 07' 14" E, a distance of 287.53 feet to a point,

Thence, 3 - S 88° 43' 39" E, a distance of 13.12 feet to a point,

Thence, 4 - Southeasterly along a curve which has a radius of 340.00 feet, a distance of 120.21 feet to a point,

Thence, 5 - S 88° 43' 39" E, a distance of 803.83 feet to a point,

Thence, 6 - S 44° 37' 46" E, a distance of 143.63 feet to a point,

Thence, 7 - S 00° 31' 54" E, a distance of 142.48 feet to a point,

Thence, 8 - S 89° 46' 07" W, a distance of 1,336.65 feet to a point,

Thence, 9 - Northerly along a curve which has a radius of 5,694.58 feet, a distance of 277.71 feet to a point,

Thence, 10 - S 88° 43' 39" E, a distance of 287.83 feet to a point,

Thence, 11 - N 01° 16' 21" E, a distance of 16.22 feet to a point,

Thence, 12 - N 38° 32' 57" W, a distance of 76.54 feet to a point,

Thence, 13 - N 88° 43' 39" W, a distance of 239.59 feet to a point,

Thence, 14 - Northerly along a curve which has a radius of 5,694.58 feet, a distance of 102.28 feet to a point of tangency,

Thence, 15 - N 02° 04' 55" E, a distance of 177.39 feet to a point,

Thence, 16 - N 89° 52' 48" E, a distance of 180.79 feet to a point and place of beginning.

The foregoing described land is shown on a map entitled "Janders Run Subdivision", dated November 6, 2014, made by Parrone Engineering, competent engineers, duly licensed by the State of New York, showing the boundaries of the proposed Extension No. 61 with existing sanitary sewers belonging to Perinton Consolidated Sewer District No. 8 and indicating the transmission of said sewage through existing mains to the Irondequoit Interceptor sewer for transmission to the Van Lare Sewage Treatment Plant which is operated by the Monroe County Pure Waters Agency. There is an existing contract between the Town of Perinton and the Monroe County Pure Waters Agency for transmission and treatment of sewage.

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby:

ORDERED FIRST, that the Town Board of the Town of Perinton shall convene at the Town Hall, 1350 Turk Hill Road in the Town of Perinton, New York, on April 8, 2015 at 7:30 p.m., local time, to consider the aforesaid Petition and to hear all persons interested in the subject thereof concerning the same, and it is further

ORDERED SECOND, that a copy of this Order, certified by the Town Clerk, who is directed to publish such certified copy in the Perinton-Fairport Post, which is hereby designated as the official paper for the publication thereof, the first publication thereof to be not less than ten (10) nor more than twenty (20) days before the day set therein for the hearing as aforesaid, and shall also cause a copy thereof to be posted on the sign board of the Town maintained pursuant to Subdivision Six of Section Thirty of Article Three of the Town Law, not less than ten (10) nor more than twenty (20) days before the designated date for the hearing as aforesaid.
