The Park Bark



Our Parks Department is here to help you decide which tree to purchase this holiday season:

Balsam Fir - Dark green, short soft needles. Branches are strong and withstand heavier ornaments. They also have a sap blister which can be broken to release a pine aroma.

Colorado Blue Spruce - Very strong branches will hold up heavy ornaments.

Concolor (white fir) - Unique foliage color and strong needle retention.

Douglas Fir - Blueish color with full branch/needle coverage.

Charlie Brown Tree - Best for unique placement of ornaments and children's' art.
