Thousands of blooms fill George Eastman's Conservatory and Palm House with the sights and scents of spring in this annual display. During Eastman's residency in the 900 East Avenue mansion between 1905 and 1932, he ordered tens of thousands of bulbs from Holland to display in his garden. The trip includes guided tour of the Eastman House, access to the Dutch Connection display, and round-trip transportation. The cost is \$13.
