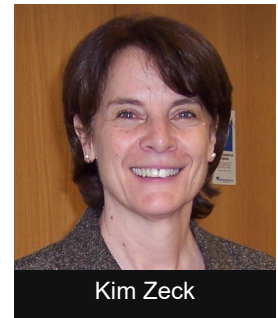
## Sports Skill Camps
