# REGULATIONS

1. All camp sites require a permit. Permit holders must be at least 21 years old, have a valid license or state ID., and furnish the full names of everyone in the camping party. All campers under 21 must be accompanied and supervised by the permit holder. <http://www.dec.ny.gov/outdoor/7817.html>

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2. Camping permits will be issued in season only (May 1<sup>st</sup> to Oct. 1<sup>st</sup>) and limited to 2-7 day stays.
3. All campers will occupy and place equipment only in assigned campsites. By camping at any of the assigned locations, you agree to adhere to Town Code 159 Prohibited Act Policy in its entirety. <http://ecode360.com/6739987>
4. The Town of Perinton is not responsible for the security of any camping equipment or personal possessions.

## ***DOGS***

5. Proof of a valid rabies inoculation must be provided before any dog is allowed in a campground. The actual certificate of current rabies vaccination as issued by the veterinarian is required. Dated collar tags are not accepted as proof of vaccination. Pets must be confined or leashed to restrict them to the campsite of the owner and cannot be left unattended. Dogs must be walked on a leash and under control at all times. Pet owners must properly dispose of the animal's excrement. By camping at any of the assigned locations, you agree to adhere to Town Code 78 Restrictions Policy in its entirety. <http://ecode360.com/6739107>

## ***FIRES***

6. All fires must be built in a Town of Perinton fire pit or grill. Fires are only permitted for cooking and warmth. No fire shall be started until all nearby flammable material has been removed. Firewood cannot be gathered on site except from dead and down trees. Fires cannot be left unattended. <http://www.dec.ny.gov/outdoor/7827.html>.  
*By transporting firewood, you could be spreading diseases and invasive insects that can quickly kill large numbers of trees. Help stop the spread and obey the [Firewood Regulation](#). 7. The use of electric generators while camping is prohibited. Violators of this policy may be evicted.
8. Pesticides or pest control can only be applied to the confines of a tent or directly to the person. It is prohibited for use on any parks land or facility.
9. No person shall dispose of any garbage, sewage, metal or glass containers, refuse, waste, fruit, vegetable, foodstuffs, paper or other litter, except in receptacles where provided for such purposes.
10. Water fountains for drinking are available in season only (May 1<sup>st</sup> to Oct. 1<sup>st</sup>).
11. Shower facilities are available for additional fees depending on permit and location.

### ***ALCOHOL POLICY***

12. All alcoholic beverages are prohibited in any park without the expressed consent and in areas specifically designated by the Commissioner. All persons possessing and consuming alcohol must be of legal drinking age. No person shall become intoxicated.
13. Drinking alcoholic beverages including beer is prohibited within 50 feet of the parking lots and rights-of-way within any park.
14. Consumption of any alcoholic beverages within the Village of Fairport is prohibited (i.e. Potter Park).

### ***GENERAL RULES***

15. Prohibitive acts include but are not limited to gambling, loud or outdoor amplified music, boisterous or indecent language, littering, defacing any park property (trees, buildings, shrubs, lighting, etc.), and polluting any park waters.
  16. The Town of Perinton is not responsible for damage to vehicles and personal property left in the park. Maximum speed limit is 20 miles per hour on all park roads.
  17. Horses, snow mobiles, motorcycles, minibikes, ATV's, use or possession of firearms, air-guns, sling-shots, bows, fireworks, and other dangerous weapons are not permitted on park grounds.
1. All activities must be properly supervised.
  2. The Town of Perinton shall not be liable for any injuries or liabilities incurred by users of facilities.

### ***ENFORCEMENT***

3. No person shall conduct themselves in a manner dangerous or offensive to self or other park users. No person shall interfere with any law enforcement or municipal staff in performance of his/ her duty.
4. Recreation and Parks staff, Fairport Police, Monroe County Sheriffs, and New York State Police shall enforce the above rules and have the authority to eject any person or seize any property in violation of the stated rules.
5. Common park areas are always open to the public including but not limited to parking lots, playgrounds, sidewalks, trails, docks, picnic tables, grills, and restrooms. Sport fields, tennis, volleyball, and basketball courts are available to reserve.

### ***PENALTIES***

6. Violation of any regulations shall be punishable as a misdemeanor subject to a fine no less than \$50.00 or more than \$1000.00 and/or imprisonment.
