## Rec Zone School Day Camp

We are excited to support our community during this difficult time. The Rec Zone program will run full days for students in grades K-7 during their days off of school. Daily activities will include computer/virtual learning time, sports/gym time, craft/game time, lunch/snack time, and other age appropriate activities. Due to capacity restrictions, the program will only be available for participants every other Wednesday. Participants will be placed in age appropriate groups. We will continue to offer our Fun Zone and Mid Zone after school programs which will all be moved to the Teen Center at Potter Park for the days your child(ren) is/are in school. Transportation will be provided from Fairport schools to the teen center. Program spots will be determined through a lottery system which will be finalized on 8/19. ## Preschool Splash to resume

As the phased reopening of the Perinton Community Center continues we will begin Parent/Preschool Splash on 8/24. This program is parent/guardian use of the leisure pool with one or two preschool aged children. This will be available on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday from 9:00 - 10:00am and 10:30 - 11:30am. For Perinton residents, the fee is \$5.00 for parent and one child (\$2.00 for additional child). You can purchase a 10x stamp pass for \$45. Non-residents can participate with a punch pass only at this time (\$63). Reservations are required and capacity is limited to 6 parent/child groups per time slot to ensure appropriate distancing. ## FULL SCHOOL DAY REC ZONE PROGRAM FUN/MID ZONE AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAM



The Town of Perinton recognizes the challenges our families face as we head into the school year. We are here to help and provide supervision when your child(ren) is/are not physically in school. We are proud to offer two programs that could benefit families.

### Rec Zone (Full Day)

This all-day recreation camp meets the needs of the families in our community looking for supervision on virtual school days. We provide adult supervision in a fun, safe, and caring environment. Healthy snacks, outdoor games, sports, swimming, projects and mandatory quiet time are provided. Quiet time is scheduled everyday with encouragement for kids to complete schoolwork. Students are required to bring their own electronics for virtual learning. Students will attend the program based on cohort scheduling. Wednesday's whole virtual school days; cohorts will alternate every other week. Parents must provide a lunch.\*\* Parents are responsible for transportation to and from the Perinton Community Center.
