

TOWN OF PERINTON LEGAL NOTICE  
LOCAL LAW #5 OF 2020  
AMENDMENT TO SECTION 16-5 OF THE  
CODE OF THE TOWN OF PERINTON  
MEMBERSHIP ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION BOARD

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that at a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Perinton, to be held at Town Hall, 1350 Turk Hill Road, Fairport, NY 14450, on Wednesday October 14, 2020, at 7:30 pm, a public hearing will be held to consider amending the above section of the Town Code. A summary of the change follows:

Article I. Amendment of Town Code section 16-5, membership, Environmental Conservation Board

1. **Legislative Intent.** New York State General Municipal Law, section 239-x (3) addresses the number of members on a local conservation advisory board said provision provides that “such council shall consist of not less than three nor more than nine members who shall be appointed by the local legislative body and serve at the pleasure of such body for a term not exceeding two years.”
2. **Perinton Town Code, Chapter 16. Environmental Conservation Board – section 16-5 membership.** The Town Code of the Town of Perinton currently establishes the number of conservation board members at nine. When the board was established as a nine member board, development was rampant in the Town as the Town was experiencing a rapid period of growth. Since that time, development has waned in the last several years and membership has been at or around seven members for several years, and the work of the conservation board has continued to excel with that number of members ever since.
3. **Applicability.** The provisions of this local law shall apply only to section 16-5 of the Perinton Town code, reducing the number of Environmental Conservation Board members from nine to seven members. All other terms and provisions of Chapter 16, Environmental Conservation Board would remain in full force and effect.
4. **Severability.** If any section, paragraph, clause, phrase or provision of this law shall be adjudged invalid or held unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, any judgement made thereby shall not affect the validity of this law as a whole or any part thereof, other than the part or provision so adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional.
5. **Effective Date.** This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State pursuant to Municipal Home Rule Law.
