Please do not feed your pets outside, this can un-intentionally attract a wide variety of animals. Coyote sightings are normal at all hours during the spring months, but if one is acting aggressively or if any animal is sick/injured, please report it immediately by giving us a call at (585) 223-5115 during our operating hours Monday - Friday 7:30 am - 4 pm, or for after-hours emergencies, please call (585) 425-7380.
