


Every day we are surrounded by fire protection systems and many of us don't even realize it. Each of these systems is inspected regularly to ensure it is ready to function when needed. Help do your part to ensure these systems will work when needed.

Sprinkler Systems

- Keep storage at least 18 inches away from sprinkler heads.
- Ensure Fire Department
 Connections, sprinkler risers and controls are all kept clear.
- Do not tamper with control valves.
 Valves should always be kept open.
- When working near sprinkler systems – consult Safety and Security for impairment needs.







- Keep fire alarm panels and pull stations clear at all times.
- Report any trouble alarms.
- Do not tamper with alarm devices.
- When conducting work in the area that can generate smoke or fumes – consult Safety and Security for impairment needs.
- When alarms go off, don't investigate GET OUT!
