GENERAL POOL RULES

- 1. Pool area is closed when no lifeguard is on duty.
- 2. Instructions of lifeguards must be obeyed at all times.
- 3. All patrons must shower before entering pool.
- 4. Appropriate bathing attire must be worn (swim suit). No cutoffs or street clothes.
- 5. Street shoes are not allowed on the deck.
- 6. Children of diaper wearing age MUST wear swim diapers or plastic pants with tight fitting elastic legs. Disposable diapers will not be allowed.
- 7. No running, horseplay, chicken fights, or pushing allowed in the pool area.
- 8. Diving is permitted under Instructor Supervision and in over seven feet of water in the lap pool.
- 9. No food, gum, drinking (except water), or tobacco products (e-cigs) in the pool area.
- 10. No glass containers allowed in the pool area
- 11. Discharge of any bodily matter is prohibited.
- 12. No unacceptable public displays of affection.
- 13. Only Coast Guard approved, properly fitting personal flotation devices permitted.
- 14. Masks, fins and snorkels are allowed for designated programs only.
- 15. Swimmers wishing to swim in water deeper than their height must first pass a deep water test.
- 16. Children ages 5-11 must be accompanied by an adult (18+ years) in the pool area. Adult must be in proper swim attire
- 17. Children ages 4 and under must be within an arm's reach of an adult, 2 children to 1 adult.
- 18. Children ages 5 and under may not use the whirlpool.
- 19. Children ages 11 and under may not use the whirlpool unless accompanied by an adult.
- 20. Participants must be at least 48" tall to go down the slide.
- 21. Failure to comply with the pool rules may result in expulsion from the facility and no refunds will be provided.

Rules for the Lap Pool

- 1. Only lap swimmers will be permitted in lap lanes
- 2. Go under the lap lanes- not over
- 3. No sitting or hanging on the lap lanes
- 4. No playing on the stairs or on the railings

Rules for the Leisure Pool

Current Channel

- 1. Move in the direction of the current
- 2. No climbing over the walls
- 3. No horseplay/No splashing

Vortex

- 1. No more than 5 people in at a time.
- 2. Heads must always be above water, no underwater swimming.

Slide Area

- 1. No one under 48 inches is allowed
- 2. Feet first, face up at all times.
- 3. One person allowed at a time.
- 4. No stopping on the slide.
- 5. No flotation devices allowed on the slide.
- 6. No running on the stairs.
- 7. Riders must clear the Splash pool area immediately.
- 8. Patrons should use the stairs to exit the pool.
- 9. No catching children at the bottom of the slide.

Zero Depth Beach

- 1. No climbing on the waterworks.
- 2. No sitting on the geysers.
- 3. No running in the shallow water
- 4. No climbing over the walls

Frog Slide

- 1. Children 47 inches tall and under are allowed on the slide
- 2. Feet first only
- 3. Exit from the slide immediately
- 4. No climbing on the frog
- 5. One child at a time
- 6. No playing with the jets or spouts
- 7. Must use the stairs no climbing back up the tongue

Whirlpool Regulations

- 1. The maximum capacity for the whirlpool is 10 bathers.
- 2. Anyone under the age of 6 may not use the whirlpool.
- 3.Elderly persons and those suffering from heart disease, diabetes, high or low blood pressure, pregnant women, or persons using prescription medication should consult their physician before entering the whirlpool.
- 4.No one under the age of 12 may use the whirlpool unless accompanied by an adult. (18 years of age or older)
- 5.Do not spend more than 15 minutes in the whirlpool. You may shower, cool down and if you wish return for another brief stay. Long exposure may result in nausea, dizziness, or fainting.
- 6.No horseplay, splashing, or swimming in the whirlpool.
- 7. No toys, balls, or playthings of any kind are allowed in the whirlpool.
- 8. No flotation devices of any kind.
