


## HIERARCHY OF CONTROLS

Did you know that there are multiple ways to address and control every potential hazard in the workplace? It's everyone's job to do their part in eliminating hazards.



- **ELIMINATION** Remove the hazard. Ex: Outsource a project.
- <u>SUBSTITUTION</u> Substitute a safer process or chemical. Ex: Utilize a water based solvent as opposed to chemical solvent.
- **ENGINEERING CONTROLS** Utilize engineering to isolate people from the hazard. Ex: Equipment Guarding, Ventillation, Physical Barriers.
- <u>ADMINISTRATIVE CONTOLS</u> Workplace policies, training, breaks, rotations, etc. Ex: Town Safety Manual
- <u>PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT</u> If Hazard cannot be avoided, equipment to protect the employee from the hazard. Ex: Safety Glasses, Gloves, Hard Hat, etc.
