CURRENT PROJECT STATUS

SIDEWALK CONSTRUCTION TO BEGIN ALONG ALDRICH ROAD

Monroe County Department of Transportation in conjunction with the Town of Perinton will have a contractor start construction of a new concrete sidewalk along Aldrich Road. Work is expected to start on or around **August 5, 2024**. The project limits for the sidewalk are from Aldrich Glen to Ayrault Road.

The sidewalk will be installed along the east side of Aldrich Road from Aldrich Glen to Royale Drive. It will switch to the west side of Aldrich Road from Royale Drive to Monarch Drive and then back to the east side from Monarch Drive to Ayrault Road. As part of the project, we will also install marked pedestrian road crossings for Aldrich Road at Royale Drive and Monarch Drive where the sidewalk switches sides of the road. The crossings will also include appropriate pedestrian crossing sign installations.

Traffic will be maintained along Aldrich Road during construction using shoulder closures, and at times, alternating one-way traffic (with flaggers) when needed.

Barring any unforeseen delays, we expect this project to be completed in approximately 3 months after the start date.

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ALDRICH ROAD CULVERT REPLACEMENT PROJECT (BETWEEN MONARCH DRIVE & TEAL DRIVE)

This informational newsletter will provide periodic updates (as needed) on the status of the Aldrich Road Culvert Replacement Project and communicate upcoming construction activities to local residents.

CURRENT PROJECT STATUS

NOTICE: Road Closure to begin May 22, 2024

Monroe County DOT will be starting the Aldrich Road Culvert Replacement Project which will require a road closure with a posted detour.

Aldrich Road will be closed to all traffic at the White Brook tributary crossing which is located between Monarch Drive and Teal Drive. This road closure and posted detour will begin **May 22, 2024 at 9:00 a.m.** and will be in effect for approximately 90 days. This closure is needed in order to safely replace the existing culvert crossing with a new one. Aldrich Road will be open to local traffic only up to the culvert work area, but it will not be passable. A detour will be posted for through traffic and will utilize Ayrault Road, Mason Road and NYS Route 31 (see back of page for detour route map).

Project Description:

This project includes the excavation and removal of the old concrete box culvert which is in poor condition. It will be replaced with a new wider box culvert to accommodate a sidewalk and wider paved road shoulders. The project also includes relocation of the water main around the new culvert, as well as the installation of new guiderail. We recognize that this project may be an inconvenience, but we ask for your patience for the protection of our workers and the traveling public. Barring any unforeseen delays, we expect this project to be completed in approximately 90 days from the start date of the road closure.

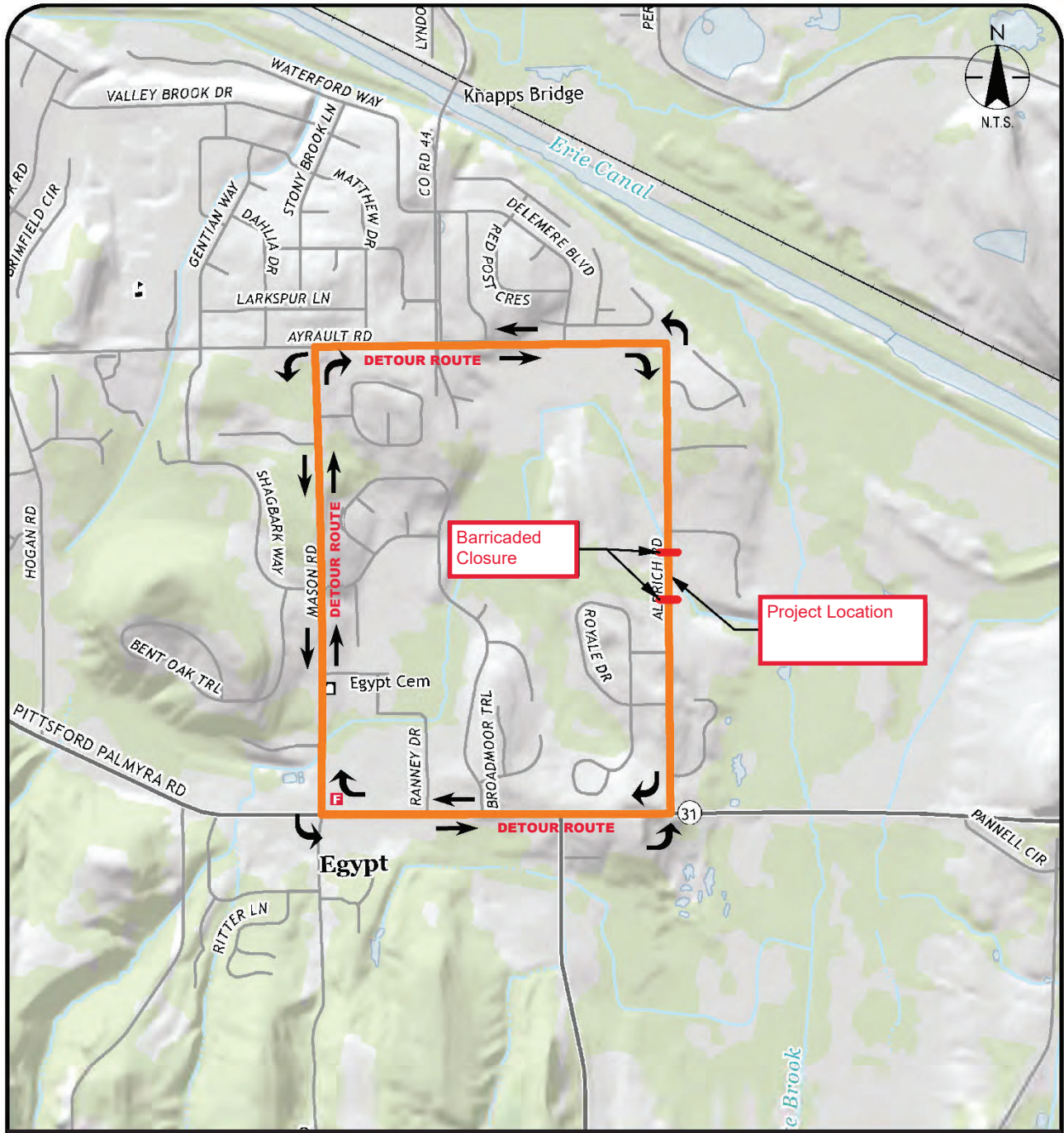
