PINES OF PERINTON CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

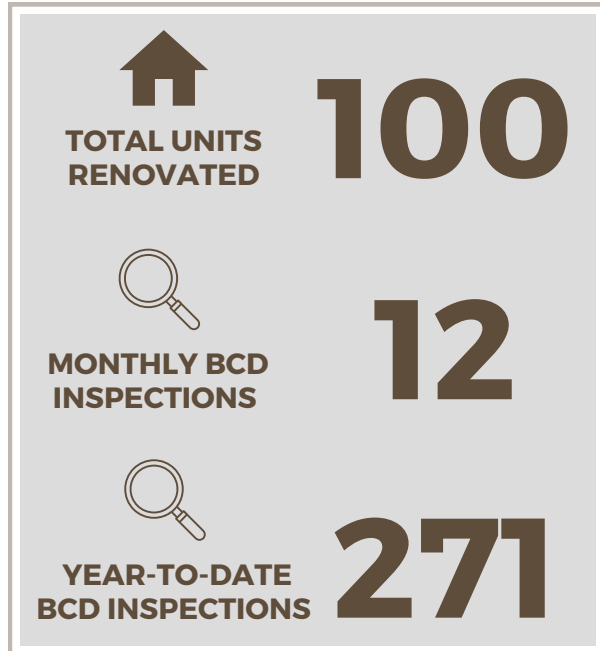
KEY POINTS:

1. Tenant Association:

Winn Co./Pines of Perinton staff continue to hold regular meetings with the newly established Tenant Association. The tenants meet with representatives of WinnDevelopment, WinnResidential, Connected Communities, the HousingToHome relocation consultant, and DiMarco Constructors. The association is looking for additional members if any residents of the Pines of Perinton are interested in joining their neighbors. 2. Community Celebration Day:

Scheduled for Wednesday, June 26, from 4:30 to 7:30PM, exclusively for Pines residents and invited guests. The event will feature food trucks, face painting, balloons, animals, a bounce house, music, and more. White Pine Circle will be temporarily closed from Whitney Road to just past the Community Center to accommodate the event.



3. Construction Progress:

The construction team has completed 100 total units. Additionally, the 19 units that were destroyed in the fire have been rebuilt and are now fully rented.

4. Playground and Pine Games:

New playground equipment is planned for installation in July. A temporary shade structure will be set up in the upper field for the Perinton Recreation & Parks Pine Games Summer Camp, followed by the construction of a permanent pavilion. The Pine Games Camp will run from July 9 - August 15.

5. Reporting Issues and Maintenance:

Residents are strongly encouraged to promptly report any issues encountered during the renovation process to the maintenance team at the Pines of Perinton. Perinton Building & Codes Department is also readily available to address concerns involving health or safety issues.
