Parking Lots

- Only park in designated parking areas.
- Ensure valuables are kept out of sight and your vehicle locked.
- Be aware of your surroundings.
- Assume other motorists can't see you and stay out of the path of moving vehicles.

Parks

- Dress appropriately for the weather.
- Bring adequate water to stay hydrated.
- Observe all of the park rules posted at the entrances.
- Stay on designated trails and paths.
- Clean up after yourself.
- Ensure your pets are kept on leash until in a designated off leash area.
- Do not feed wildlife.
- Be alert and observant of your surroundings.
- Stay out of bodies of water. These may have unseen hazards.
- Whenever possible, enjoy our parks and trails with a friend.
- Bring a cell phone with you to quickly access 911 in the event of an emergency.

Facilities

- Familiarize yourself with your closest emergency exit, fire extinguisher and fire alarm pull stations.
- Be alert and attentive to your surroundings.
