Portable fire extinguishers are the first aid tools of the fire world. In order to use them effectively, the user needs to know the correct type of fire extinguisher for the class of fire.

Fire Classifications

Class A – Ordinary combustible materials like paper, cloth, wood, cardboard and rubbish.

Class B – Flammable liquids such as paints, solvents, fuels and greases.

Class C – Energized electrical equipment.

Class D – Flammable metals such as magnesium and potassium.

Class K – Cooking Oils and Fats
