

PERINTON COMMUNITY GARDEN

Share the Harvest Guidelines

Description:

Gardening with a group allows for a larger variety and yield for each gardener. Specific vegetables and layout is designed each year, depending on share the harvest members. All gardening tasks and harvests are shared equally. As part of this garden membership, approximately 30% of the food grown will be donated.

Harvest Guidelines:

Every time you work in the garden you are allowed to harvest and take home any food you will eat from the S.T.H. section only. This is judged by the honor system. The amount of food you take home should equal the amount of work you put into the garden. All Perinton Community Garden Rules apply to the S.T.H. garden.

Responsibilities:

1. Each S.T.H. member is responsible for weeding, watering, planting and harvesting.
2. Each S.T.H. member is expected to participate in at least 2 designated work and plant days. These dates will be provided by the garden coordinator during the current season.
3. Each S.T. H. member is expected to perform 4 weeks of garden maintenance duty. Scheduled weeks are from Sunday to Saturday starting in mid-May. If you are unable to fulfill the week/weeks you committed to, it is your responsibility to switch your week/weeks with another STH gardener. Notify the garden coordinator in advance. The maintenance schedule will be provided by the garden coordinator for the current season. Sign up is first come first serve, but the coordinator will do their best match up priorities/choices.
