

SPRING LAKE TRAIL CONSTRUCTION

Project Update

The Town has started work constructing 2,100 feet of new trail along Irondequoit Creek! This new trail will connect Spring Lake Park to the existing Irondequoit Creek Trail which currently extends 6.2 miles from Irondequoit Bay through Channing Philbrick Park in Penfield to the Perinton Town Line. The trail will generally follow an existing foot path along Irondequoit Creek and will feature a 3 foot to 5 foot wide stone dust surface. Large stone will be installed to stabilize a 300 foot long portion of eroded creek embankment, and a timber framed bridge will be constructed where the trail crosses an overflow channel. The majority of the project will be paid for with Federal Funds and the Town expects the trail to be constructed and open to the public by late October 2023.

The project will require temporary closure of the existing foot path north of Spring Lake Park so the contractor can safely construct the new trail facility. Trail Closed signs on barricades will be posted at the north and south end of the project area.

Brown Rock Property Management LLC is the Town's contractor constructing the trail. Brown Rock has begun preparing their staging area and moving equipment into the project site. The tentative construction schedule is as follows:

Award Contract: April 2023 (Completed)

• Construct Staging Area: Mid-July 2023

Install Temporary Creek Crossing: Late July 2023

• Tree Removals: *Early Aug 2023*

Creek Embankment Stabilization: *Mid-Aug 2023*Trail Construction: *Mid Aug—Mid-Oct 2023*

• Open Spring Lake Trail: Late Oct 2023

Landscaping & Plantings: Fall 2023 and/or Spring 2024
